Eligible Projects	Project to replace, rehab, preserve, or protect one or more bridges on National Bridge Inventory (NBI). A project under the BIP program that includes bridge bundling and culverts.

Development phase activities, including planning, feasibility analyses, revenue forecasting, environmental review, preliminary engineering and design work, and other preconstruction activities, 2. Construction, which includes replacement and preservation, reconstruction, rehabilitation, acquisition of real property, environmental mitigation, construction contingencies, acquisition of equipment, and operational improvements directly related to improving system performance. 		
Additional Information	The project is expected to begin construction not later than 18 months after the date on which funds are obligated; and (2) preliminary engineering is complete for the project.
