Program Description	The purpose of this Cooperative Agreement (CA) is to support federally recognized tribal governments in developing processes and tools to assess and address pedestrian safety on their tribal lands.		
Project Priorities	Projects should align with the National Roadway Safety Strategy (NRSS) Projects should be consistent with Executive Order 13985, Advancing Racial equity and Support for Underserved Communities Through the Federal Government.		
Eligible Costs	Costs associated with the development of processes and tools to assess and address pedestrian safety on their tribal lands.		
Additional Information	No cost sharing or matching is required however, it is encouraged. \$507,000 is available to fund one awarded cooperative agreement.
