

## Defense Community Infrastructure Pilot Program Grant

<b>Eligible Applicants</b>			
State or local government, not-for-profit, member-owned utility.			
<b>Program Description</b>	Funds to assist State and local governments to address deficiencies in community infrastructure supportive of a military installation. Community infrastructure projects are transportation projects, community support facilities, and utility infrastructure projects that are located off of a military installation or on property under the jurisdiction of a Secretary of a military department that is subject to a real estate agreement, and are owned by a State or local government or a not-for-profit, member owned utility service.		
<b>Unique Program Items</b>	Complete and eligible proposals from eligible entities will be evaluated against specific criteria, successful proposals will be invited to submit a formal grant application.		
<b>Eligible Projects</b> (Pg 6)	All proposed projects must be construction-ready and must result in a complete and useable project.		
<b>Eligible Costs</b> (Pg 8)	Construction and renovation costs, as well as costs of capital equipment affixed to the real property. Soft costs, such as those required for the planning, design, permitting, and National Environmental Policy Act compliance must be funded by non-Federal project cost contribution funds		
<b>Selection Criteria</b> (Pgs 17-20)	<p>Projects will be selected in the following order of priority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. That will enhance military value at a military installation,</li> <li>2. That will contribute to the training of cadets enrolled in an independent program at an educational institution,</li> <li>3. That will enhance military installation resilience and,</li> <li>4. That will enhance military family quality of life at an installation.</li> </ol>
