Program Description	This notice combines two programs: the Reconnecting Communities Pilot (RCP) Program and the	
	Neighborhood Access and Equity (NAE) Program, referred to jointly as the Reconnecting Communities	
	and Neighborhoods (RCN) Program. The RCP Program aims to advance and support reconnection of	
	communities divided by transportation infrastructure – with a priority on helping disadvantaged	
	communities improve access to daily needs. Funds are to be awarded to support planning and capital	
	construction activities to restore community connectivity through the removal, retrofit, mitigation or	
	replacement of highways, roadways, or other infrastructure facilities.	
Eligible Projects	Community Planning Grants for Both RCP and NAE: Public engagement activities, including	
	community visioning or other place-based strategies for public input into project plans.	
	Community Planning Grants for NAE only: Planning and capacity building activities in disadvantaged	
& Costs	or underserved communities.	
(NOFO 14- 16)	Capital Construction Grants for Both RCP and NAE: Preliminary and detailed design activities and	
	associated environmental studies; predevelopment / preconstruction; permitting activities including	
	the completion of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process.
